This person could be a teacher, psychologist, social worker, or any other faculty member who can attest to the student's character. A form for this letter is included in the application packet and should be returned directly to the scholarship committee by the faculty member.

Applications should be completed and sent to the guidance counselor at each high school by April 6, 2017.
